If you are making hot shot van deliveries or pick-ups of Seafood, Poultry, Meat, Dairy, Produce, Groceries, Plants/flowers, or catering supplies, the Johnson custom-molded, resin-coated, fiberglass-reinforced plywood lining designed to protect cargo vans (Ford, Chevy, etc.) and new van designs (Sprinters) from corrosion and excessive wear and tear.
